- 4.) In sending the proof of payment, please use your <u>FULLNAME</u>, <u>STUDENT NUMBER</u>, <u>Payment</u> for <u>COMPLETION</u> as the <u>email SUBJECT</u> and include the following details:
 - a.) Date/Time of online transfer/over-the-counter deposit.
 - b.) Bank where funds came from.
 - c.) The last three (3) digits of the account number where the transfer came from; and
 - d) Send it to jphorlina@arellanolaw.edu OR accounting@arellanolaw.edu.

Thereafter, an electronic mail will be received from the Office of the Dean regarding the action taken on your application.

If approved, the electronic mail will contain the schedule of the completion examination, which will be during the scheduled Final Examinations this semester for the subject concerned and under the same professor from the previous semester.
